In addition, we have completed the new counter on the east wall of our dining room. It looks nice and provides some additional storage as well as providing a wider path to the Tiki. Our plan going forward is to start the clearing and improvement of our new property to the east as soon as we have 15K set aside from operations. Last season all our free cash flow went to the engineering and legal expenses associated with the transfer of the property to our name. Including \$21,200 in legal fees and \$13,300 in engineering.
